

Pine

Dinesen Pine primarily comes from three selected areas in Germany. Here, the trees grow slowly, they become large and straight, and are typically between 150 and 200 years old. They are felled in the winter when the first frost has arrived.

Dinesen only uses the lower 5-10 metres of the log, which typically has a diameter between 40 and 55 centimetres. The German pine has fewer but slightly bigger knots than the Nordic pine.

The old trees are utilized and used with respect. After cutting, drying and planing, the planks are sorted into three grades, of which the two best are used for floors.

Both selections have close growth rings. The proportion of heartwood varies. The planks generally contain few knots. Bad knots have been replaced with fresh ones, just as minor knot holes are repaired.

Classic

Has a harmonious, calm and discreet expression. Fewer knots than Natural.

Natural

Has slightly more and bigger knots and thus gets a more vivid, authentic and warm expression.
